We challenge stigma and fear, so that voices-hearers and support people can respond in more compassionate and helpful ways to voices.

Approach, and the lead facilitator is Louisa D Pearce,
a Social Worker with her own lived experience of
voice-hearing, recovery from schizophrenia, and
experience working in trauma-sensitive ways.
